Overview

- Career readiness and hunger solutions are pillars of the WCA ag program utilizing a hydroponic system, tower gardens, 24 apple tree orchard and a mobile meat processing trailer
- The FFA chapter focuses heavily on service learning

Experiential Learning

- All students enrolled in Ag Ed Classes at WCA complete an SAE project, Students work on school-based SAE projects throughout the each in the greenhouse
- Eric supervises the Work based learning program

Last year, 42 chapter proficiency applications were completed

- Eric is CASE certified in AFNR and Ag Business Foundations
- Served on the MAAE officer team and NAAE finance committee
- Assisted in writing a bill and securing \$350,000 to provide funding to high school meat processing programs
- Selected as one of 25 educators worldwide to participate in a global guides program that focused on food security

- Has had 7 CDE teams or individuals compete at the National FFA Convention

Partnerships

- Raised over \$350,000 in grants and donations for a greenhouse from local businesses, civic groups and alumni
- Was awarded \$378,000 from the USDA to purchase a mobile meat processing lab shared with WCA and Ashby Ag Ed

 hear updates about the program and his FFA officer team
