- Highland park AFNR department began over 10 years ago
- Have incorporated 5 new courses over the past 3 years
- Expanded the program to a two person department
- The program has over 720 students enrolled in the program each year
- Transitioned the program to affiliate FFA membership model

Experiential Learning

- Implemented an "SAE for all" model to ensure all students were exploring potential career pathways and gaining experience
- Incorporated the "Earn as you Learn" program for students to earn certifications in OSHA agriculture, automotive, culinary, Microsoft and are paid for their time to complete their certifications
- Developed a Floral Design School Based Enterprise

FFA Highlights

- Over 45 individuals have competed in 15 CDE's and LDE's with over 30 students to the State FFA Convention
- Some "firsts" for Highland Park FFA include their first state degree, first Region IV Officer, First team placing in the top three at state and first team to compete at the National level

- Secured over \$80,000 in grant funds from organizations to fund new lab equipment for biotechnology, update kitchen equipment for sustainable food production and general classroom upgrades
- Strong partnerships through the SPPS AFNR Advisory Board
- Additional partnerships include A. Johnson and Sons Floral shop, Happy Land Christmas tree lot, Canine inspired change and best prep
