The Glencoe-Silver Lake Agricultural Education Program is based in Glencoe, MN and is home to 1,492 students that serves six towns. Students grades 7-12 can sign up for elective AFNR courses encompassing seven AFNR career pathways. Supervised Agricultural Experiences are included in all 28 courses taught in a school year with a capstone Work Based learning course. Glencoe-Silver Lake has a 35-member alumni called the Ag Promoters and a strong advisory board consisting of professionals in all AFNR areas.
